As a Graduate Teaching or Research Assistant, you will be required to perform such duties as instructing in laboratories, marking assignments and/or conducting research. The number of hours of work will be determined based on a standard rate of pay established by the University, for graduate students, and the amount you receive. The hours of work may not be divided equally for each month during this appointment period. Prior to receiving a Teaching Assistantship, students must complete the Department's Teaching Assistantship training. Further information regarding this training will be provided once you arrive.

This offer is contingent upon you maintaining full time registration and satisfactory academic progress in your degree program (minimum GPA of **3.0**/4.0) and upon satisfactory completion of your assigned duties as a teaching and/or research assistant. Eligibility for assistantships from the Department may be affected should you be the recipient of other awards or scholarships. It is your responsibility to inform us if you receive any such awards from other sources.



In accepting this offer, applicants should be aware that any program or supervisor requirements stipulated in this letter of offer must fully adhere to the requirements set by the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research (FGSR). Where requirements are in contradiction, FGSR requirements will supersede those of the supervisor and program.

We must have your decision concerning this offer within three (3) weeks of the date of this letter; otherwise this offer will become null and void, and the financial support will be allocated to another candidate.
