The funding outlined in this letter can be from multiple sources including, but not limited to, teaching and/or research assistantships, research project support, graduate research fellowships, scholarships, and awards.

The funding outlined in this letter is expressly contingent on your being able to commence all aspects of your program by the original admission start date of . If you are unable to commence your program, for whatever reason or circumstance, by the original admission start date, funding may no longer be available or possible. This funding offer is only valid if you are residing in Canada. You must report to the Department Graduate Office in person upon arrival and submit your valid study permit and SIN to the central HR through the Staff Service Centre to initiate the payment.

As a Graduate Teaching or Research Assistant, you will be required to perform such duties as instructing in laboratories, marking assignments and/or conducting research. The number of hours of work will be determined based on a standard rate of pay established by the University, for graduate students, and the amount you receive. The hours of work may not be divided equally for each month during this appointment period. Prior to receiving a Teaching Assistantship, students must complete the Department's Teaching Assistantship training. Further information regarding this training will be provided once you arrive.
